NEIGHBOURHOOD AND MASTER PLAN

Residences on Dalgleish enjoy breathtaking combinations of manicured golf course outlooks and high alpine vistas beyond.

Baxter Design Group have skilfully merged the very best elements of Millbrook Resort's landscapes with an attractively diverse landscape plan including English specimen trees, expansive green lawn space and soft hedge screening. This design is complemented by striking schist stone retaining walls which define each side boundary. The landscape to the north melds seamlessly with the rolling fairway of the golf course.

Two stunning design options (The Stirling and The Braemar) are available on the generously proportioned freehold sites ranging in size from 1,050m² to 1,260m². Each is easily accessed from the south side off gently meandering Dalgleish Lane.

Careful placement of each home on individually elevated building platforms that step up gently to the west provide welcome privacy, maximum sunlight and exceptional views. Impressive individual forecourts afford a real sense of arrival at each of these stunning homes while multiple outdoor living spaces contribute to the sensational lifestyle on offer.



TYPE A FLOOR PLAN

THE STIRLING

With an expansive floor area of 406m², The Stirling offers delightful single level living in a magnificent fairway-fronting location.

Masterful architectural design creates four separate pavilions, two of which are charming stone buildings capped with dark slate roofs. These structures are placed either side of a central glass and timber/steel pavilion that reaches out towards the golf course. The fourth pavilion contains the commodious internally accessed garaging complete with drying cupboard and ski rack.

Accommodation consists of two delightful master bedrooms, each with luxuriously appointed ensuite bathrooms and walk-in wardrobes. Two further ensuited guest bedrooms, separate powder room, large laundry, spacious kitchen/dining/sitting/living

areas, splendid media room, wine room and cleverly positioned office all contribute to the practicality and appeal of this charming home.

The impressive entry area complete with an exquisite up lit curved stone wall commands the centre of each home and links the sleeping and living quarters.

Fashioned in the spirit of a contemporary glass and wooden Central Otago barn, the living pavilion attracts all day light and year round sun with 180° views of the surrounding Crown Range, Arrow Valley and iconic Coronet Peak.





TYPE A

THE STIRLING (CONTINUED)

The stunning light filled Ingrid Geldof designed kitchen complete with integrated appliances takes pride of place at the heart of the home. An adjacent 'in view' scullery works as an extension of the kitchen and can simply be closed off with a thoughtfully positioned cavity slider.


The combined kitchen/dining/living room spaces open out to three separate terraces to the east, north and west, maximising opportunities for sun entry, shade and shelter.

Outdoor living/entertaining is so inviting under the practical 'Louvretech' roof covering the alluring, nicely sheltered and superbly private loggia area which has a northerly aspect. Accessed off both the dining area and master bedroom, this area also features a built-in gas barbeque, inviting fireplace and generous seating space.

THE BRAEMAR

The Braemar design is distinctly different from The Stirling design as it features four parallel pavilions, one that incorporates a practically positioned second floor level.


The welcoming entry lobby leads on through to the centrally located living pavilion incorporating the expertly designed kitchen by experienced and proven Ingrid Geldof Design and expansive open plan dining/living/sitting areas.

Located on the eastern side of the ground floor is the sumptuous master bedroom wing complete with impressive walk through dressing room and luxurious bathroom. Bi-folding doors lead out to a sheltered terrace with brilliant views of the golf course. Three generous and equal sized guest bedrooms, each with its own superbly

appointed ensuite bathroom and built-in wardrobes are located on the ground and first floors offering guests the opportunity to relax and enjoy their stay in pure luxury.

Other ground floor features include expansive internally accessed garage with separate door for your golf cart, thoughtfully positioned powder room, wine room, ski rack and drying cupboard and spacious laundry that opens to a practical service court.





TYPE C

THE BRAEMAR (CONTINUED)

Judiciously placed between the bedroom wings, the central pavilion is at the centre of the site and fashioned as an elegant, spacious light filled contemporary wooden barn. Incorporating a grand stone fireplace, finely crafted timber trusses and rich timber ceilings and floors throughout the entire length of the room add to the exceptional texture and elegance of this magnificent central structure

A notable feature of The Braemar is the placement of the media room which is connected to the internal space of the living room close to the built in bar. This room also opens out to the alluring loggia and barbeque/fireplace area. Sheltered by an automated louvre roof as well as a series of adjustable timber shutters, your continued comfort into the late afternoon and evening is assured.

The Braemar residences are places of warmth, sophisticated luxury and comfort.
